

SCHEDULE FOR A RADIO SHOW

a Roots to Leaves event



- This document aims to describe a typical radio show, created from interviews, contributions and purposes linked to Roots to Leaves
- The radio show has local radios as subjects of first choice, but it can also be applied to radios with national coverage.
- All activities take place in compliance with the 2016/679 privacy regulation (GDPR)

CONTENT

- Interviews / testimonies of life during the crisis and historical memory from the area, interspersed with music as a soundtrack.

REPORTERS

- Radio speaker
- Interviewees, by phone, web or in the area (when possible)
- Interviewees on the territory, people who want to tell their story, for example a wartime experience or an extraordinary thing that they experienced in the past or present day during the coronavirus emergency: the elderly, vulnerable ones, lonely people, children, population in general
- Guests in the studio (when possible) or by phone, with the possibility of performing live songs during the show, also at request of listeners linked to particular memories, experiences or life moments.



SCHEDULE

Duration of the episode: 90 minutes

5' Introduction and greetings from the speaker

10' Presentation of the guest in the studio/on the phone - dialogue / interview

5' song

10' external link with first interview on the territory

5' *song*

10' dialogue / first part guest interview in the studio / via telephone

5' *song*

10' external link with second interview on the territory

5' *song*

10' dialogue / second part guest interview in the studio / via telephone

5' *song*

5' thanks, final greetings, future appointments, closing
